Brown Bag—Take home projects in the workroom that the teachers need done, like sharpening pencils, cutting laminated pieces, assembling, etc.

Carnival—All hands on deck for this October event! Help in all areas working booths, monitoring bounce houses, help with set up, clean up, etc.

Chess Club—Meets twice a month after school for an hour, assist teacher in charge, volunteers rotate

Clinic Aide—Assist with screenings, organizing clinic supplies & extra clothing

Copy Room—Make copies for teachers and pta needs, on rotating schedule and when you have free time!

Dad's Club—Hosts several events per year, including Thanksgiving Luncheon, Christmas Caroling at Larson, set up and tear down at Carnival, Field Days and other PTA events, Open Doors in Drop Off line monthly, etc.

Field Days—Two days in May, assist with PTA concessions, set up, assist Coach

Grade Level Rep—Heads Room Reps for each grade, works with teachers to coordinate parties and events

Junior Achievement—Teach Jr Achievement for 6 weeks, one hour each lesson, every grade participates

Kindergarten Roundup—Assist with welcoming new cubs and their parents, introducing them to the school, - happens in the Spring

Landscaping—Are you a green thumb? Assist in maintaining beds & flowers

Library—Help is always needed shelving, new book processing, etc.

Mentoring—Mentor a student through the Cub Care program.

Office Aide—Assist office personnel as needed—copying, etc.

Popcorn Fridays—On a rotating schedule, assist with popping popcorn for tutoring rewards

Red Ribbon Week—Held in the Fall for Drug Awareness, assist coordinator as needed.

Room Rep—Representative from each classroom to coordinate parties, events and work with teacher if there are additional needs.

Silent Auction—Held during the Fall Carnival, assist with obtaining auction items, set -up, check out, properly displaying items in baskets, etc.

Spirit Sales—Assist with PTA chair during sales: last Friday of every month, PTA Programs

Test Monitoring—Help keep the halls quiet during testing times.

Technology—Are you a techie and love to help? Let us know, lots of various opportunities!

TGIF Lunch Delivery—On a rotating schedule each Friday, per grade, ordering and delivering lunches to teachers, teachers pay for their own food.

Work Room—Help complete misc projects needed such as sharpening pencils.
